Public Access Computer Use

Law Library public access computers are to be used for legal research ONLY.

You **can't** use Law Library computers to access anything **not** connected to legal research.

Law Library staff may set time limits on public access computer use.

Due to the limited Law Library resources available for providing public access to legal research resources on the internet, the Library reserves the right to periodically set time and other limits on the use of Library computers.

You may e-mail legal research material to yourself, as long as the material is in the public domain or is non-copyrighted.

Law Library computers **aren't** set up to allow downloading to your own drive.

The Law Library regularly deletes files from Law Library computers.

You may print for \$0.10 per page.

The Law Library doesn't charge for the first 10 pages.

You may use 1 Law Library public access computer at a time.

You may not download or upload software or other executable files to or from the Law Library computers.

You may not alter or damage the current settings of the Law Library computers.

You may not use Law Library computers for any illegal activity.
